⁷It is in Christ and through the blood of Christ that we have been redeemed and our sins forgiven, so immeasurably generous is God's favor ⁸given to us with perfect wisdom and understanding. ⁹It is in Christ that we find out who we are and what we are living for. Long before we first heard of Christ and got our hopes up, he had his eye on us, had designs on us for glorious living, part of the overall purpose he is working out in everything and everyone.

¹¹In Christ we were willed an inheritance; for in the decree of God, and everything is administered according to the divine will and counsel, we were predestined ¹²to praise the glory of the Most-High by being the first to hope in Christ. ¹³In Christ you too were chosen.

¹⁴ It's in Christ that you, once you heard the truth and believed it (this Message of your salvation), found yourselves home free—signed, sealed, and delivered by the Holy Spirit. This signet from God is the first installment on what's coming, a reminder that we'll get everything God has planned for us, a praising and glorious life.

¹⁸I pray that God will enlighten the eyes of your mind so that you can see the hope this call holds for you and the promised glories that God's holy ones will inherit.
